This breed has been a major part of my life and it made me feel very proud to end up with a shortlist of 7 excellent examples of the breed each very worthy of winning the CC.

Puppy (9)

1. Masters' Manchela Tiger Tim

Black & white at the top end of his puppy career. Presents a stunning well balanced outline stacked and maintains this on the move. Good depth and width for his age. Great legs and feet. Well angulated throughout. Shown in gleaming coat and condition. Sound and outgoing, moves with drive. Excellent presentation and handling. A very promising adult career now awaits him. BPIS.

2. Glendinning's Plaiglen D'Artagnon

9 month old blue roan. Lovely well balanced appealing head with dark eye. Good in shoulder and upper arm. Neat legs and feet. Sound happy mover. Just needs to mature in body.

3. Lewis's Penmartan Marcelo

Novice (4)

1. Bond's Cassom Fast And Furious At Olibond

14 month old blue roan. Gorgeous balanced head with lovely dark eye. Good width and depth of forechest. Excels in shoulder and upper arm. Well boned legs with great feet. Firm well angulated hindquarters. Sound happy mover. Excellent presentation.

2. Sherlock's Spur Of The Moment For Lochranza

14 month old blue roan. Good balance to head with appealing expression. Well balanced in outline. Neat legs and feet. Sound.

3. Pickford's Swanmarch Rocket Man

Graduate (9)

1. Thomas's Abercrombie Of La Vie Magnifique For Claramand JW

Very flashy 14 month old light blue roan. Masculine head. Excellent neck, shoulder and upper arm. Good width and depth of forechest. Well ribbed and bodied for his age with great bone. Short & compact outline. Strong hindquarters that provide great drive. Personality plus and at times gives his handler a hard time but she is winning the battle! Sound. Shortlisted for CC.

2. Collins' Cassom Sky Rocket At Candyke JW

16 month old dark blue of great type. Lovely dark eye and expression. Great neck and shoulders. Good forechest. Lovely legs and feet. Well rounded hindquarters. Shown in excellent coat and condition. Sound.

3. Gladman's Chativore Cortez

1. Bond's Sh Ch Olibond Remember Me JW

4 year old blue roan, a great favourite of mine that has won under me previously. Masculine well balanced head. Textbook forehand construction, neck flows smoothly through shoulders into topline. Good bone with excellent neat feet. Well rounded hindquarters. Presented in excellent coat and condition. Sound. Shortlisted for CC.

- 2 year old light blue roan of different type. Good width of forechest. Well boned legs and neat feet. Big ribbed body. Short and compact outline. Sound and outgoing. Very Cockery.

1. Pretty's Sh Ch/Int/Bel/Hun Ch Joaldy Mandolin Wind JW ShCM CW'12

Multi award winning 5 year old black and white. Appealing eye and expression. Good bone and substance. Well ribbed balanced outline. Uses his hindquarters well to provide sound hind movement. Good tail action. Shown in gleaming well presented coat and condition.

2. Pearce-Gudger's Pearkim Philanderer

Strong masculine 2 year old upstanding orange roan.

Good quality bone and lovely neat feet. Needs to fill out and develop in body. Shown in well presented coat. Outgoing and sound.

- 11 month old black. Well balanced masculine head with appealing eye and expression. Good in neck and shoulders. Quality bone, substance and coat. Great legs and feet. Good width all through with lovely rounded backend. Sound.
- 2. McCabe & McGregor's Grandfully Aarto
- 9 month old black. Well balanced outline with good reach of neck. Moves away soundly, just needs to fill out in front. Quality coat well presented.

- 1. Glennerster & Palmer's Glenntree Graceland
- 12 month old black. Short, square and compact outline. Appealing head and expression on good neck and shoulders. Great legs and feet. Well rounded backend. Shown in gleaming coat and condition, excellent presentation. Sound.
- 2. Burns' Globetrotter Of Pearl Lagoon Among Villaspaniol NAF TAF
- 3 year old black & tan. Different type to 1. Well angulated throughout with good flow through neck and shoulders. Sound moving backend but needs more width in front. Very well presented.

- 1. Ward's Wensum Jamesons On Ice
- 19 month old black. Sweet head and expression. Well rounded body with good bone and spring of rib. Neat legs and feet. Sound.
- 2. Pretty & Davies's Kerriglow Fable With Joaldy JW
- 2 year old black. Masculine head. Good reach of neck. Short and square outline. Sound.
- 3. Black Lord Paint In Black For Claramand (Imp HRV)

Open (4)

- 1. Rueda & Sanchez's Sp Ch Lujesa Xalvador
- 2 year old quality black of great type. Refined masculine head with lovely eye and expression. Well angulated throughout. Flows so well from the tip of his nose down his good length of neck through clean well placed shoulders into firm level topline. Stands on superb legs and feet. Short, square balanced outline. Good width to hindquarters that allow him to move freely, soundly and with drive. Legs, feet and hocks were trimmed to perfection showing off his very precise and correct footfall. Shown in immaculate coat and condition. A pleasure for me to award him the RCC from a quality line-up.
- 2. Costello's Judika Arizona

Mature 3 year old black & tan. Masculine head, dark eye, rich tan markings. Good neck which flows well through shoulder into good topline. Balanced outline. Well conditioned hindquarters provided sound hind movement. Gleaming coat very well presented.

3. Marris-Bray's Weirdene Wake Up At Helenwood JW

Red, Golden, Liver, Liver & Tan

Puppy (3)

1. Nathalie's Joy De L'Orme A Lieue

9 month old mature golden. Well balanced masculine head with gorgeous dark eye and expression. Good length of neck which flows into well placed shoulders. Quality bone and thickly padded feet. Well rounded and angulated hindquarters. Sound happy mover. Excellent presentation.

2. Gilmour's Chavez Royal Dedication

11 month old golden. Lovely head and eye. Good neck and shoulders. Balanced outline. Neat legs and feet. Just needs to mature in body. Sound.

3. Snell's Whinburn Mystic Masquerade At Amaclassic

Novice (2)

1. Cottebrune's Joker Of Merrily

11 month old golden. Good outline. Well angulated throughout. Flows beautifully from his masculine head through well placed shoulder and upper arm to his well conditioned hindquarters. Quality coat very well presented. Outgoing with sound driving movement.

2. Robinson's Jozelah Marinho

2 year old golden. Different type to the first. Sweet head with lovely eye and expression. Short, square and compact in outline. Excellent legs and feet. Well bodied with a lovely rounded backend. Shown in full coat very well presented and handled.

Graduate (4)

1. Irwin's Rayol Charlie Cairoli At Brightgrass

2 year old golden. Strong masculine head, a little heavy in the back skull. Square and balanced in outline. Would prefer better angulation to hindquarters and better presentation.

2. Burns' Claramand Rough Copy At Villaspaniol

2 year old golden. Sweet head with lovely eye and expression. Neat legs and feet. Compact outline. Very well presented. Unfortunately he just didn't get it together on the move.

Special Open (7)

1. Young's Sh Ch Canyonn Classic Illusion JW

At 4 years old he looked as good as I've ever seen him. Neat front. Good length of neck which flows well into his topline. Well balanced outline. Mature, well rounded body. His hindquarters are an object lesson in how to trim, and when settled this enabled him to show off his sound hind movement. Excellent coat and condition. Shortlisted for CC.

2. Rueda & Sanchez's Schuss De Mister Cocker

Quality 3 year old golden with great bone and substance. Masculine head with lovely eye. Excellent legs and feet. Strongly made body with good ribs and wide rounded hindquarters. Lovely coat very well presented. Sound.

3. Simonelli's Euro/Int/Multi Ch Gallinagos All This Time

Veteran (10)

1. Reid's Sh Ch Shanaz Sporran JW

7 year old blue roan. Top winning Scottish Cocker. Well balanced masculine head with appealing eye and expression. Neat front. Scored here in shoulder and upper arm. Excellent legs and feet. Good width of chest and spring of rib. Short backed, good proportions. Outgoing and sound. Superb presentation and handling.

2. Wildman & Edwards Sh Ch/Is Ch Travellers Joy Of Malpas

7 year old dark blue roan. Masculine head. Good length of neck. Firm level topline. Well rounded hindquarters. Moved soundly with drive. Excellent coat and condition and another that is presented and handled to perfection.

3. Dewhurst's Sh Ch Lapidary Rebel Rebel

Minor puppy (12)

1. Platt's Charbonnel Whisky N Soda

6 month old orange roan. Still carrying a thick puppy coat but this exhibitor has the sense to know not to force it out until it's ready. Underneath the fluff is a short and compact outline. Scored in neck and shoulders, forechest, ribs, bone and strength in hindquarters for one so young. A delightful temperament, enjoying every minute and showing with such confidence. Sound. BMPD

2. Cox's Gardenstone Pale Rider To Suvern

8 month old light blue roan. Lovely head, eye and expression. Good in neck, shoulder and upper arm. Well bodied with lovely rounded backend. Has a tendency to lose his topline when stacked which spoilt an otherwise splendid outline but his many other qualities won him his placing. Shown in excellent coat very well presented. Sound.

3. Masters' Manchela Paco Rabanne

Puppy (14)

1. Todd & Rahman's Lynwater Classic Design

There have been some great Cockers from the Lynwater kennel and this one could well follow in their footsteps. 10 month old blue roan with a gorgeous well balanced masculine head and dark eye. Good reach of neck which flows well into firm level topline. Good width of forechest. Neat legs and feet. Well ribbed body. Sound happy mover with good tail action. Presentation and handling first class.

- 12 month old blue roan. Well grown and mature for his age. Strong masculine head with dark eye. Good forechest, strong bone, well ribbed. Powerful hindquarters. Balanced outline. Outgoing and Sound.

15 month old blue roan. Well balanced, short and compact outline. Good neck and shoulders. Neat legs and feet. Well rounded backend. Very well presented. Sound.

3. Leslie's Ferrersedge Chronos

Yearling (6)

1. Amos-Jones' Sh Ch Veratey Vincenzo At Cassom JW

Having silently admired this 21 month old blue roan from ringside as a puppy I was so looking forward to judging him and he didn't disappoint. Quality masculine head that is so well balanced and without a hint of coarseness. Lovely soft appealing eye and expression. Excellent forehand construction, legs and feet. Short, cobby and compact body but with the strength and angulation to his hindquarters that allows him to power around the ring so soundly. He maintains not only a perfect topline but also a perfectly carried ever wagging tail. As always with this exhibitor he was shown in the very best coat and condition that was expertly prepared. DCC from a quality line-up and delighted that my co-judge Duncan Craig agreed with me to award him BIS. Very well deserved.

2. Sablons' Sunset D'Hell Jador Dior

14 month old golden. Quality balanced head. Excellent outline. Strong bone. Neat legs and feet. Flows so cleanly through good neck and shoulders into firm level topline. Well rounded body and hindquarters. Fabulous coat, beautifully presented and very well handled. Outgoing and sound.

3. Garrard's Clavaire Silver Dollar

Maiden (4)

1. Evans & Pavey's Joneva Phileas Fogg

13 month old blue roan of good make and shape. Masculine well balanced head with lovely dark eye. Moved soundly coming and going. Just needs to mature in body.

2. Collins' Snugborough Soul Power To Candyke

13 month old blue roan. Excellent legs and feet. Balanced outline. Well made hindquarters provided sound hind movement. Just preferred the head and more positive front movement of 1. Very well presented.

3. Sherlock's Spur Of The Moment For Lochranza

Tyro (2)

1. Mason & Robertson's Lynshow Kuckoo With Zheridons

13 month old black. Appealing masculine head with sweet expression. Good forechest, bone and rib. Neat legs and feet. Well rounded backend. Presented in good coat. Very outgoing but just carried his tail a tad low. Sound.

Special Beginners (8)

1. Hillary's Sheigra Mr Snugles At Edasiy

4 year old strongly made black. Masculine head with dark eye. Good bone and feet. Reachy neck flows well into firm level topline. Strength in hindquarters. Shown in excellent coat and condition. Sound.

2. Reeder's Kaniboo Midnight Diamond ShCM

8 year old black. Refined masculine head. Neat legs and feet. Well sprung ribs and rounded hindquarters. Quality coat very well presented. Sound.

3. Sherlock's Jayzander Blue Moonlight At Crimicar

Post Graduate (11)

1. Bunting's Allert's Knock Out At Mossdew (Imp Swe)

2 year old black & white. Strong masculine head. Short, square well balanced outline. Very Cockery. Sturdy well made body with excellent bone and neat feet. Good width of forechest and spring of rib. Moved soundly keeping a good topline.

2. Babester's Kalispell Bespoke JW

2 year old dark blue roan. Lovely head. Scores in shoulder and upper arm. Excellent legs and feet. Beautifully presented. Sound.

3. Burnet's Charmwen The Sorcerer

Minor Limit (3)

1. Gilmour's Chavez Royal Dreamer

Strongly made 2 year old black. Great legs and feet. Dark eye, good forechest, well ribbed, strong hindquarters. Sound. Excellent coat and condition.

2. Ward's Wensum Black Lightning JW

2 year old black. Sweet head, neat legs and feet, well ribbed, short compact body. Sound

3. Gladman's Chativore Steel Symphony

Limit (10)

1. Ellson's Withiflor Rolling Stone JW

2 year old golden. Quality balanced head with lovely dark eyes and pigmentation. Good length of neck which flows into well placed shoulders. Strong bone and neat thickly padded feet. Good proportions, stunning outline. Strongly made body. Moved soundly. Shortlisted for CC.

2. Telford's Courtmaster Musicman

20 month old chocolate roan. Masculine head on good length of neck, flowing well into firm level topline. Scores in bone and substance. Deeply padded feet. Well muscled hindquarters that produce good drive. Very well presented and expertly handled.

3. Seaman's Oakrosa Rhett Butler

1. Ullebo's Sh Ch/Dk N Uch Rainstorm's Latest News DKV'12'13 WW'13 JV'11

Delighted to get the opportunity to get my hands on this 4 year old light blue roan and I was impressed. Flows beautifully from his balanced masculine head to the tip of his well carried ever wagging tail. Good width of forechest. Excellent legs and very neat feet. Clean through neck and shoulders. Well ribbed body. Movement sound and true with perfect topline. Excellent presentation. Shortlisted for CC.

2. Nicholas-Steele & Eastwood's Marquell McCready By Kalrizienne

Good honest type of 4 year old blue roan that has won under me previously. Well balanced masculine head. Good width of forechest. Strong well ribbed compact body and rounded backend. Could maybe carry a tad less weight to his advantage. In great coat very well presented. Sound.
